Objectives	The purpose of this course is: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. to develop a student skill to read and write in Cyrillic, 2. to deepen the student understanding of the basic principles of Russian grammar; 3. to develop the student beginning vocabulary in Russian; 4. to develop the student basic communicative skills in Russian; 5. to deepen the student understanding of Russian culture; 6. to improve the student understanding of Russian culture in the context of the modern global challenges.
Learning Outcomes	Student will be able to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> LO1 Read and write basic Russian in Cyrillic alphabet; LO2. Analyze basic Russian sentences grammatically; LO3.
